

CHASSAGNE-MONTRACHET, CHAMPS DE MORGEOT Lamy-Pillot

Bourgogne, Côte De Beaune, AOC Chassagne-Montrachet

The vineyard

A deep, structured wine which maintains a silky texture on the palate, our Chas-sagne-Montrachet village, Champs de Morgeot lives up to its reputation as a powerful, long-keeping red from the great "Morgeot" climat. The area, situated on alluvial deposits of sand and silt, lies at the foot of the slope. The "Champs de Morgeot" cuvée benefits from high stoniness. Its relatively low clay content allows for finesse in the wine's tannic profile.

Topographic location

LOWER TERRACE AND ALLUVIAL CONE (Santenay side): 15 to 20 meters above the current Thalwegs, generally made up of silts and fine sands.
