Oogwink Shiraz 2021





Tempel Wines, (Est. 1784) is a boutique winery on the banks of the bergriver in Paarl, South Africa.

All their wines are natural fermented and the vineyards are farmed as biological as possible.

Tasting notes:

Named after the phrase that translates into "an eye wink", the 2021 Oogwink comes with a compressed frame of red florals before red spice and smoked black peppercorn mingle with hints of cured sausages. Medium to full bodied. The palate displays fine-grained tannins with elegance and precision offering notes of cherry and peppercorn and delightful finish.

• Soil: Sandy soils

• Vinification:

Natural fermented in open concrete tanks. Manual punch downs during fermentation at 20-25 C. Matured in 300L French oak barrels and concrete egg for 12 months.

Stellenbosch and Swartland
