A nose full of dark chocolate coated fruits - so appealing. I love the bright nature of the red fruits on the palate and the milk chocolate cocoa powder that dusts the sides of the mouth, this has a fine grip and commands attention. It's delicate and refined but has such a stylish aspect, so curated and sculpted, not muscular - it's gentle but direct and focused with clarity. The wood aspects appear just on the finish giving nuance but this is charming no doubt.

Dark garnet, purple hues on the narrow rim. Delicate notes of tobacco and red cherries, fine herbal savouriness, fresh orange zest. Medium-bodied, red cherry and blackcurrant fruit, integrated tannins, lemony finish.

Taillefer - aromatic nose of violets and morello cherries, good intensity on the palate, nice complexity and length, ripe tannin, velvety texture. Smooth aftertaste. Adorable effort. **91p.**

The palate is medium-bodied with slightly hard tannins and misses some substance on the mid-palate, but there is at least freshness and sapidity on the finish.
